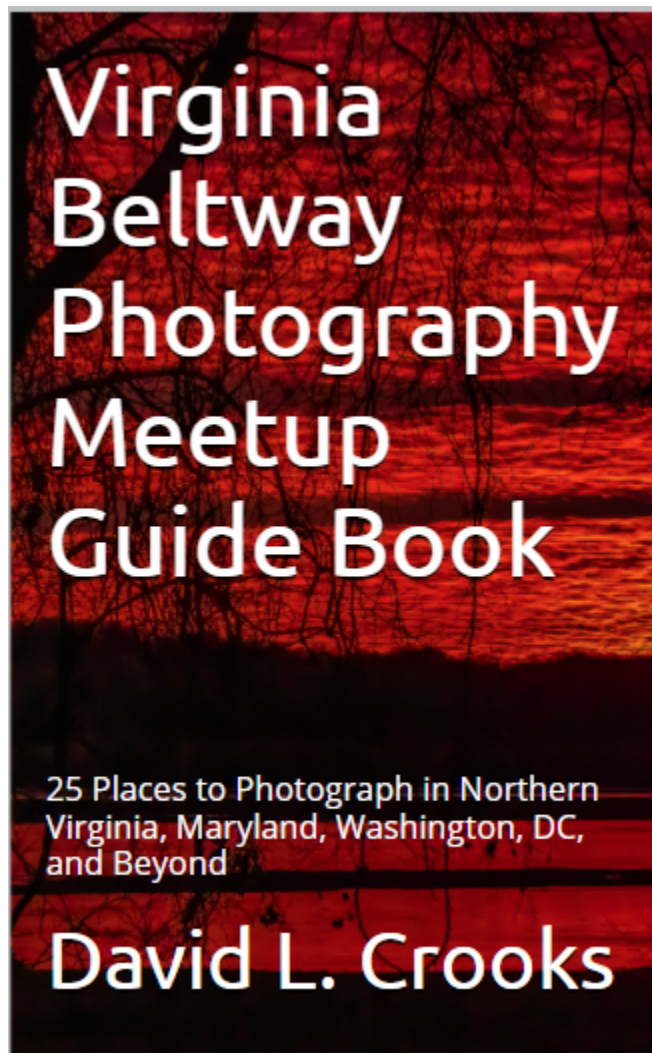

All locations	January 2024	All Info to Know sections	Added Accessibility information and What3Words codes for better locations.
76	January 2024	15 - McKee-Beshers Wildlife Management Area	In 2023, Field #1 on River Road was not planted. Five fields were planted and they were scattered throughout the Wildlife Area.
81	January 2023	16 - Burnside Farms	In 2023, the group attended the evening event, for \$26, which included a band, food trucks (cost extra), fireworks, and 3 sunflowers.
85	January 2024	17 - Conowingo Dam	We made two trips in 2023 to the dam, once on April 2nd when the Shad was running and then the day after Thanksgiving. Both were pretty successful trips with good views of the bald eagles fishing. The number of bald eagles is still fairly low.

About 10 folks showed up in the rain to walk from Union Station down H Street. We had lunch at a local restaurant and a blue sky appeared as we made our way back to Union Station.

The Group also went the day after Thanksgiving in 2022 and saw a few bald eagles but the rainy weather conditions made it tough to get many good photographs.</p>
93	January 2023	19 - State Arboretum of Virginia	<p>The Group had a couple of field trips in October 2022. In October 23rd, the trees were practically at peak. We went back on October 30th and there were still some trees with yellow leaves, but they were dropping quickly.</p>
